REFUND POLICY INFORMATION:

IMPORTANT: The GlobalWorks Cancellation Policy is effective from the time a student agrees to pay their non-refundable deposit or electronically signs the program commitment form, regardless of application or acceptance status. It is essential to read this policy before a potential cancellation takes place, in order to understand the ramifications.

PROGRAM DEPOSIT: A non-refundable program deposit of \$500 is due within two weeks of acceptance, unless otherwise specified. The program deposit is not an additional fee but is part of

the total GlobalWorks program fee. Once paid, the program deposit is non-refundable except in cases where a student is denied acceptance to the program for which he or she has applied. Students who fail to pay the program deposit by the first cancellation listed below for their program will have their program application cancelled.

CANCELLATION PENALTY:

CANCELLATION DATE	PENALTY IF NOTICE RECEIVED AFTER THIS DATE
March 15	Student agrees to \$500 program deposit. Deposit is refunded if student is not accepted or placed.
Before April 19 at 5 pm	Student is responsible for the deposit and any additional fees accrued
Between April 20 and May 5 at 5 pm	Student is responsible for 50% of the program costs, as well as the deposit and any additional fees accrued
After May 5 at 5 pm	Student is responsible for 100% of the program costs, including deposits and any additional fees accrued
