Cancellation Date	Cancellation Penalty
Upon acceptance to program	Student agrees to \$500 non-refundable program deposit
Cancelling 8 weeks - 1 day before program start date	Student is responsible for 50% of total GEO program fees
Cancelling on or after program start date	Student is responsible for 100% of total GEO program fees

Note that scholarship funds are not able to be applied to program deposit.

IMPORTANT: The GEO Cancellation Policy is effective from the time a student agrees to pay their non-refundable program deposit or electronically signs the program commitment form, regardless of application or acceptance status.
