### **Cancellation Policy**

Note that scholarship funds are not able to be applied to program deposit.

**IMPORTANT:** The GEO Cancellation Policy is effective from the time a student agrees to pay their non-refundable program deposit or electronically signs the program commitment form, regardless of application or acceptance status. It is essential to read this policy before a potential cancellation takes place, to fully understand the withdrawal and cancellation penalties, and to understand what it means financially to commit to a study abroad program.

Students who cancel their participation must notify GEO in writing. Email is acceptable (<a href="mailto:geoinfo@uoregon.edu">geoinfo@uoregon.edu</a>). Verbal notification to GEO or notification given to a non-UO campus study abroad office is not sufficient.
