Cancellation Policy

| Cancellation Date | Cancellation Penalty |

| Upon acceptance into the program | Student agrees to \$500 non-refundable deposit. Deposit is refunded if student is not initially accepted by the provider. |
| 60 - 45 days before program start | Student is responsible for 25% of the program costs and any additional fees accrued. |
| 45 - 30 days prior to program start date | Student is responsible for 50% of the program costs and any additional fees accrued. |
| Less than 30 days before program start | Student is responsible for 100% of the program costs and any additional fees accrued. |

Note that scholarship funds are not able to be applied to program deposit.

IMPORTANT: The GEO Cancellation Policy is effective from the time a student agrees to pay their non-refundable program deposit or electronically signs the program commitment form, regardless of application or acceptance status. It is essential to read this policy before a potential cancellation takes place, to fully understand the withdrawal and cancellation penalties, and to understand what it means financially to commit to a study abroad program.

Students who cancel their participation must notify GEO in writing. Email is acceptable (geoinfo@uoregon.edu). Verbal notification to GEO or notification given to a non-UO campus study abroad office is not sufficient.
