## **Cancellation Policy**

<b>Cancellation Date</b>	<b>Cancellation Penalty</b>
Upon acceptance into the program	Student agrees to \$500 non-refundable deposit. Deposit is refunded if student is not initially accepted by the provider.
60 - 45 days before program start	Student is responsible for 25% of the program costs and any additional fees accrued.
45 - 30 days prior to program start date	Student is responsible for 50% of the program costs and any additional fees accrued.
Less than 30 days before program start	Student is responsible for 100% of the program costs and any additional fees accrued.

*Note that scholarship funds are not able to be applied to program deposit.*

**IMPORTANT:** The GEO Cancellation Policy is effective from the time a student agrees to pay their non-refundable program deposit or electronically signs the program commitment form, regardless of application or acceptance status. It is essential to read this policy before a potential cancellation takes place, to fully understand the withdrawal and cancellation penalties, and to understand what it means financially to commit to a study abroad program.
