Cancellation Policy

Cancellation Date	Cancellation Penalty
Upon acceptance to program	Student agrees to \$500 non-refundable program deposit
11 weeks before program start date	Student is responsible for 20% of total GEO program fees
Cancelling within 8 weeks of the program start date	Student is responsible for 55% of total GEO program fees
Cancelling on or after the program start date	Student is responsible for 100% of total GEO program fees

Note that scholarship funds are not able to be applied to program deposit.

IMPORTANT: The GEO Cancellation Policy is effective from the time a student agrees to pay their non-refundable program deposit or electronically signs the program commitment form, regardless of application or acceptance status. It is essential to read this policy before a potential cancellation takes place, to fully understand the withdrawal and cancellation penalties, and to understand what it means financially to commit to a study abroad program.

Students who cancel their participation must notify GEO in writing. Email is acceptable (geoinfo@uoregon.edu). Verbal notification to GEO or notification given to a non-UO campus study abroad office is not sufficient.
