Included in Program Costs: Program tuition, housing, breakfast, lunch and dinner Monday through Friday, medical insurance, pre-departure orientation, on-site orientation, and on-site support. All instruction, including two half-day excursions and one full-day excursion weekly for "The Ancient City," course; additional half-day

excursions for Cultural Heritage and Renaissance/Baroque Art History courses, transportation for all course-related trips, all admissions costs to museums, archaeological sites, and exhibitions, excursions and day trips, day trips to Ostia, Etruria, the Alban Hills, Tivoli, Roman colonies, the Tyrrhenian coast, and elsewhere. Eight days on the Bay of Naples (all transportation, meals, lodging, and museum/site admissions), one week elsewhere in Roman territory (all transportation, meals, lodging, and museum/site admissions), and a monthly public transportation pass in Rome.

IMPORTANT: The GEO Cancellation Policy is effective from the time a student agrees to pay their non-refundable program deposit or electronically signs the program commitment form, regardless of application or acceptance status. It is essential to read this policy before a potential cancellation takes place, to fully understand the withdrawal and cancellation penalties, and to understand what it means financially to commit to a study abroad program.

Students who cancel their participation must notify GEO in writing. Email is acceptable (geoinfo@uoregon.edu). Verbal notification to GEO or notification given to a non-UO campus study abroad office is not sufficient.
