Upon acceptance to program

Student agrees to \$500 non-refundable deposit.
Deposit is refunded if student is not initially accepted by the provider.

Withdrawal between 45 days and 1 day from program start

Student is responsible for 50% of GEO program fees and any additional fees accrued

Cancellation Date

Program start date or after
program begins

Student is responsible for 100% of total GEO
program fees

Note that scholarship funds are not able to be applied to program deposit.

IMPORTANT: The GEO Cancellation Policy is effective from the time a student agrees to pay their non-refundable program deposit or electronically signs the program commitment form, regardless of application or acceptance status. It is essential to read this policy before a potential cancellation takes place, to fully understand the withdrawal and cancellation penalties, and to understand what it means financially to commit to a study abroad program.
