Considering building your next customized program with GEO? Here are some helpful answers to some of the most commonly asked questions.

Q: Do we have to pay University of Oregon tuition since GEO is a provider housed at the UO?

A: No. GEO will only charge you the program fee listed in your proposal, which covers the program costs and does not include tuition. GEO will bill your home institution in one lump sum after your enrollments have been confirmed.

Q: What kind of credits do students receive on a GEO customized program?

A: Students will be registered on their home campus for a customized program. GEO will submit a grade report to your home institution enabling students to receive home institution credits for the courses they complete on the program.

Q: Does GEO only do full programs, or can we select program elements like lectures, classroom space, and excursions for an already existing program?

A: GEO is happy to work with you on whatever you need. Depending on location and your requested program elements, GEO will inquire with our network of international partners to see what we can offer you.

Q: What countries does GEO operate in?

A: GEO has established GEO centers in the United Kingdom, Spain, Italy, Ghana, and Argentina. In addition, we work with program partners all over the world and can work with you to build a customized program in your desired location by working with our extensive network of global program partners.

Q: What is the minimum/maximum number of students? What kind of flexibility is there after an enrollment deadline passes?

A: GEO will work with you to meet your target program price and collaborate with you on what minimum number of students we would need to participate in order to run the program and the desired price point. GEO is more than happy to collaborate after an enrollment deadline if minimum enrollment has not been met. We can work together to see if there are modifications we can make to the budget to run a program that did not meet projected enrollment targets.

Q: What if we want to provide our own (faculty/flights/guest speakers/accommodations, etc.)

A: No problem. Just let us know what program elements you would like to arrange yourself and we can remove these from our proposal.

Q: Does someone travel with our students the whole time?

A: This is dependent on location or your preference. In most cases, GEO can arrange an on site coordinator to be with your group throughout the duration of your program, which will be included in the program fee and proposal from GEO.

Q: What if we don't want to use GEO's insurance?

A: Unfortunately, we need to include our travel insurance on all programs. GEO provides comprehensive health, safety and risk management services on all of our programs and a component of this is our ability to coordinate with our insurance provider in an emergency. Don't worry though. This is a small charge per student that will not dramatically impact your program price.

Q: How much does it cost for a two-week program?

A: Our process is tailored to fit what you are looking for and depending on location, inclusions, excursions, number of students, program costs can vary significantly. However, we pride ourselves on our collaborative program development process so we can ensure we have everything you are looking for included in your proposal and we will work hard to meet your desired price point.

Q: Does GEO arrange transportation to or from the program site before it begins or after it ends?

A: GEO does not arrange group flights or transportation to and from the program site. All transportation GEO offers is only within the program dates as requested in the proposal.

Familiarization and Funding Opportunities

Faculty-led Program Development Grants

Staff and faculty are eligible for development grants that support visits to GEO centers abroad, and exploration of customized programs. GEO awards grants (up to \$3,000) to support international travel for the purpose of developing new, faculty-led study abroad programs. Grants can help fund a visit to a single site or to multiple sites within a country or region. Grant applications are due in February for expected travel between April and September of the same year.

GEO Open Houses

Don't miss out on an opportunity to visit GEO centers during our annual open houses. Site visit participants explore the host city, meet GEO staff and on-site directors, tour GEO facilities, and observe ongoing academic programs at each location. The open houses are an opportunity for our site staff to show off all of the incredible capabilities of their site and city. Your housing, meals and all activities are covered in this two- to threeday immersion in everything our sites have to offer.

Mini Grants for Faculty

Already traveling to an international location and want to add a stop at one of our GEO centers? GEO is happy to award \$500 mini grants to support your visit to one of our centers. Mini grants can be awarded anytime throughout the year.
